AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DENALI BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 3.20.045
TITLED REVIEW OF PUBLIC FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska, that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend and reorganize DBC Chapter 3.20.045 as follows:

The purpose of this section is to review detailed accounting of the expenditures of any public funds from the Denali Borough. To receive Denali Borough funds or any pass through funds, [to the borough's endorsement for any request of funds] the following requirement must be met:

A. All entities or organizations must submit to the mayor [and the borough assembly] a detailed [quarterly] accounting of the expenditures of all such funds received [from or] through the Denali Borough for the preceding calendar year. This accounting is due by March 1st, and to be available at the March regular meeting, to allow time for the current year's budget and for the consideration of any future borough endorsement requests.

B. This is required for all funds, [with the exception of state designated funds such as state funding to communities grants, school funds, public safety, and other state and federal designated funds.] Entities or organizations which do not comply with the reporting requirement under Section A, will be prohibited from receiving Borough funds and/or endorsement for any request of funds until such time as the reporting requirement has been met.

C. All such records shall be deemed public records under Denali Borough Code of Ordinances, Title I, Chapter 1.20 DBC. [Ord. 04-09 § 2.]

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon its adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Mayor.
