AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DENALI BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 4.05
TITLED, REAL PROPERTY ACQUISITION.

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska.

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a permanent and general nature.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend DBC Chapter 4.05.030 (G) as follows:

Chapter 4.05

REAL PROPERTY ACQUISITION

4.05.030 Procedural requirements.

G. The Assembly may exercise the powers of eminent domain and declaration of taking in accordance with AS 29.35.030. However, eminent domain shall be exercised only if the borough has made reasonable but unsuccessful efforts to negotiate a purchase or exchange. Eminent domain takings may only be used for public works or facilities, when no other reasonable option is available, and may not be conveyed to any private, corporate or non-profit entity.


Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Mayor.
