AN ORDINANCE ADDING CHAPTER 3.21 ESTABLISHING THE DENALI BOROUGH
MATCHING GRANTS PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska.

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to establish DBC Chapter 3.21 a matching grant program specifically targeting local projects that provide public benefit, and establishing a special committee on an annual basis to award grants if funding allows.

3.21.010 Authority.

- A. Denali Borough Charter, Article III, Section 3.02 (D).
- B. Denali Borough Code of Ordinances, 3.05.
- C. Denali Borough Code of Ordinances, 2.45.040.

3.21.020 Matching Grant Program.

The Denali Borough Matching Grant Program shall follow the guidelines as listed below:

- A. Up to three awards may be granted annually dependent upon financial availability.
- B. Programs must be provided by a public or private non-profit organization.
- C. A grant must have a minimum request of \$5,000 and may not exceed \$20,000.
- D. A 20% cash match is required by projects completion and may be spent on materials but may not be spent on labor.
- E. Agencies receiving other grants or monies from the Denali Borough, may apply for the matching grant program. Proof must be furnished that all matching funding is not coming directly from any revenue received from the Denali Borough.
- F. The program will serve Denali Borough residents without regard to sex, heritage or race.

- G. The program will not be funded retroactively.
- H. Grants will not be awarded for administrative costs, operational costs of programs, or salaries and benefits related to direct services.
- I. All promotional or printed material for any program funded through this grant must include the following statement: "This program is partially funded by the Citizens of the Denali Borough".
- J. All programs are subject to Denali Borough financial audits per Ordinance 04-09.
- K. Each grant will be awarded by Assembly Resolution and will be subject to a yeas or nays vote only.
- L. All grants are subject to an application process on file at the Borough office. Incomplete applications will not be forwarded to the grant committee.
- M. Any Agency that has previously applied for and was awarded a grant under this ordinance and failed to meet the obligations of the program shall be disqualified for a period of 2 years. Agency may also be subject to civil action for recovery of any grant monies that may have been dispensed.

3.21.030 Grant committee.

This special grant committee shall be created by resolution following DBC 2.45.040 and shall name the three (3) most recently elected members of the Denali Borough Assembly elected to a three (3) year term.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon its adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Mayor.
