AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$50,000 TO THE DENALI CHAMBER OF COMMERCE FOR PROMOTING TOURISM WITHIN THE DENALI BOROUGH.

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that;

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to appropriate \$50,000 to the Denali Chamber of Commerce for the purpose of in state and intra-state marketing promoting tourism in the Denali Borough. These funds shall be applied solely for tourism promotional purposes for the 2010 season.

Section 3. Finance. An appropriation of \$50,000 will be allocated through a budget amendment line item in the FY2010 budget.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption of the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
