AN ORDINANCE OF THE DENALI BOROUGH DECLARING SURPLUS PROPERTY
AND AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF THE SAME AND APPROPRIATING NET
PROCEEDS TO SAID SALE TO THE SOLID WASTE OPERATING BUDGET.

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that;

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to sell and remove surplus property in conformity with Section 9.14 of the Denali Borough Charter the administration is hereby authorized to post notice and sell said surplus property.

Section 3. Property. The following equipment is identified as surplus property with the purchase price listed:

1999 Samsung SL150-2 Front-end Loader	\$7,000
1979 International TD-15 Pay Dozer	\$2,500
1969 International Dump Truck	\$2,500
2008 Portable Truck wheel load scale	\$3,900

Section 4. Finance. The net proceeds of the sale of said property is to be appropriated to the Solid Waste operating budget and designated for equipment.


Section 5. Conveyance. All property will be sold as is, where is and the purchaser will be responsible for removal of said property within a reasonable time to be determined by the administration. A waiver of release will be required prior to a buyer removing the equipment.

Section 6. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
