A Resolution Expressing the Planning Commission's Opinion  
That Borough-Owned Commercial Property

WHEREAS, selling commercial land will provide a one-time fee, but will not provide consistent income for the future; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the Borough to diversify its income sources.


