RESOLUTION NO. 11-06

A RESOLUTION BY THE DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY IN SUPPORT OF CONTINUING TRADITIONAL NON-MOTORIZED HUNTING WITHIN THE YANERT CONTROLLED USE AREA IN UNIT 20A.

WHEREAS, the Yanert Controlled Use Area (CUA) was established and has been managed as a non-motorized hunting area since 1970; and

WHEREAS, the Fairbanks Fish and Game Advisory Committee has forwarded Proposal 232 to the Alaska Board of Game; and

WHEREAS, Proposal 232 would dramatically change the Yanert CUA from a traditionally non-motorized hunting area to a motorized hunting area from after September 30<sup>th</sup>; and

WHEREAS, Proposal 232 arose from a non-local advisory committee, whose intent is to increase access to the controversial antlerless moose hunt in the Yanert section of Unit 20A; and

WHEREAS, there is a lack of facilities for parking vehicles and trailers, which causes significant public safety and private property trespass concerns; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough Assembly passed Resolution 09-22 which opposes the Alaska Department of Fish and Game's continued Antlerless Moose and Any Bull Permits in Unit 20A; and

WHEREAS, the Mid-Nenana River Fish and Game Advisory Committee voted at their February 2011 regular meeting to maintain the Yanert CUA as a non-motorized hunting area.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Denali Borough Assembly requests the Alaska Board of Game to honor the wishes of the local governing bodies.

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Denali Borough Assembly requests the Alaska Board of Game reject Proposal 232.
