AN ORDINANCE CREATING DENALI BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES,
TITLE 1, CHAPTER 1.30 TITLED, FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE, AND AMENDING
CHAPTERS 2.05, 2.45 AND 8.05.

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that;

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a permanent and general nature.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to create Title 1, Chapter 1.30 Titled, Financial Disclosure, and amending Chapters 2.05.070, 2.10.120, 2.45.010, 2.45.020 and 8.05.120 as follows:

Chapter 1.30

FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE

A. Financial disclosure is required by all Denali Borough Assembly members, Denali Borough School Board members, Planning Commission members and the Denali Borough Mayor.

B. Each elected or appointed official shall complete and file with the clerk a report of financial disclosure and business interests; Denali Borough disclosure form "W", no later than April 15th of each year[, or within 15 days after he/she files his/her personal income tax return, whichever occurs first, or with write-in election to, appointment to, or announcement of candidacy to a legislative, commission or executive seat in the Denali Borough government.]

Chapter 2.05

BOROUGH ASSEMBLY

2.05.070 Financial Disclosure.

[Each elected official shall complete and file with the clerk a report of financial and business interests, as required by AS 39.50.010 through 39.50.200, no later than April 15th of each year or 15 days after he/she has filed his/her personal federal income tax return, whichever occurs first.]

A. Denali Borough Assembly members shall submit a financial and business disclosure form in accordance with and as required by DBC 1.30.

B. Participation in all borough governmental activities without the required disclosure by assembly members is prohibited.

Chapter 2.10

BOROUGH MAYOR

2.10.120 Financial disclosure.

A. The Denali Borough Mayor shall submit a financial and business disclosure form in accordance with and as required by DBC 1.30

B. Participation in all borough governmental activities without the required disclosure by the mayor is prohibited.

Chapter 2.45

BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, AND COMMITTEES

2.45.010 Boards.

C. Board members shall submit a financial and business disclosure form in accordance with and as required by DBC 1.30. Participation in all borough governmental activities without the required disclosure is prohibited.

2.45.020 Commissions.

C. Commission members shall submit a financial and business disclosure form in accordance with and as required by DBC 1.30. Participation in all borough governmental activities without the required disclosure is prohibited.

Chapter 8.05

MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

8.05.120 Conflict of interest statement requirement.

8.05.120 Conflict of interest statement requirement.

A. No candidate's nomination petition or filing fees for an elected municipal office may be accepted by the clerk unless the candidate has also filed a report of financial and business interest as required by [AS 39.50.010 through 39.50.200] DBC 1.30 In the event such petition or filing fee has been accepted without such statement, the clerk shall return such items to the candidate.

B. A write-in candidate who wins election shall execute a report of financial and business interest as required by [AS 39.50.010 through 39.50.200] DBC 1.30 prior to taking the oath of office.

C. A person who has on file with the borough clerk a report of financial and business interest as required by [AS 39.50.010 through 39.50.200] DBC 1.30 for the current year shall not be required to file such a statement required under subsection A or B of this section. Candidates are required to comply with AS 15.13.010 through 15.13.130 as regards election spending.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
