ORDINANCE NO. 05-13

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A SCHOOL TAX WITHIN THE DENALI BOROUGH.

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature.

Section 2. Purpose. This ordinance is to levy a School Tax on each person employed in the Denali Borough.

Section 3. Denali Borough School Tax. The tax shall be \$50.00 per year.

All employers shall make this deduction from the wages of each employee 18 years of age and older except for members of the military service.

The tax is to be deducted in full and paid to the Denali Borough within 30 days unless the amount earned in the first pay period is less than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) or if the employee can present proof that the School Tax has previously been paid during the same calendar year.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective on January 1, 2007 if it has been adopted by the Denali Borough Assembly, signed by the Mayor, and approved by the Denali Borough voters at the Regular Election to be held on November 8, 2005.
