AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING UP TO \$17,000 FROM THE MAJOR SCHOOL MAINTENANCE RESERVE FUND FOR ELECTRICAL UPGRADES TO THE TRI-VALLEY SCHOOL MULTI PURPOSE ROOM.

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to appropriate \$17,000 from the Major School Maintenance Reserve Fund for electrical upgrades in the multi-purpose room at Tri-Valley School. These upgrades will be code compliant and will ensure the safe operation of any necessary appliances required for use within the multi-purpose room. This will include the use of sound and lighting equipment and will expand and modify the current electrical system.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Mayor.
