AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.10.040 OF THE DENALI BOROUGH CODE OF
ORDINANCES TITLED MAYOR PRO TEMPORE

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Denali Borough Code of Ordinances,
Chapter 2.10.040 as follows:

2.10.040 Mayor pro tempore.

[Should the office of the mayor become vacant, or if the existing mayor is disabled or unable to act, the
assembly may appoint a mayor pro tempore to serve until the mayor resumes his or her official duties, or
until a new mayor is qualified. [Code 1989 § 6-4.]]

Should the office of the Denali Borough Mayor become vacant or if the mayor is unable to perform his
duties, the Presiding Officer of the Denali Borough Assembly shall be named Mayor Pro Tempore to
serve until the mayor is able to resume his responsibilities or until a new mayor is elected according to
the Denali Borough code section 2.10.090.


Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption of the Denali Borough
Assembly, signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
