AN ORDINANCE ALLOCATING FUNDING FOR THE DESIGN AND PERMITTING OF
A SEPARATE C&D LANDFILL FROM WITHIN THE CURRENT FOOTPRINT

Section 1. Classification. This is a non code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose and intent of this ordinance is to allocate funding for the development, including permitting, of a C&D (construction and demolition) pit, creating a separate landfill within the current landfill footprint. This project will eliminate the threat of emergency landfill closure due to the intake of excessive daily or cumulative tonnage each year.

Section 3. Property. The property selected to accommodate the C&D Landfill is the C&D pit currently in use (unit #5) and the C&D pit (unit #7) that is in the approved design of the landfill.


Section 4. Funding. All costs shall be appropriated from the Solid Waste Budget Line item named "C&D Landfill Design and Permitting. The estimated cost breakdown is as follows:

\$ 775	C&D permit fee (ADEC)
\$ 228	Permit Review fee (ADEC)
\$2,080	Annual fee (ADEC)
\$3,000	RFP and advertising
<u>\$30,000</u>	Consultant fee (creation and submission of permit)
Total	\$36,083

Section 5. Effective date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
