AN ORDINANCE ADDING CHAPTER 3.21.020K AND 3.21.030 REGARDING THE DENALI
BOROUGH MATCHING GRANTS PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska.

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend DBC Chapter 3.21.030 dealing with matching grant selection review committee.

3.21.020 Matching Grant Program.

K. [Each grant will be awarded by Assembly Resolution] The committee will make, by separate resolutions, recommendations to the assembly of its choices of grant recipients and will be subject to a ye or nay vote only.

3.21.030 Grant committee.

A. This special grant committee shall be created by resolution following DBC 2.45.040 and shall name the three (3) most recently elected members of the Denali Borough Assembly elected to a three (3) year term. One alternate shall be named by the assembly from the previous year's committee to serve only in the absence of a primary member.

B. The grant selection committee shall have their first meeting no later than 45 days after the matching grants are due. The grant selection committee shall make their recommendation to the assembly no later than the July assembly meeting at its regularly set date.

C. If the grant selection committee fails to adhere to the guidelines set in this section the administration shall make the recommendation to the assembly no later than the August assembly meeting at its regularly set date.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon its adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Mayor.

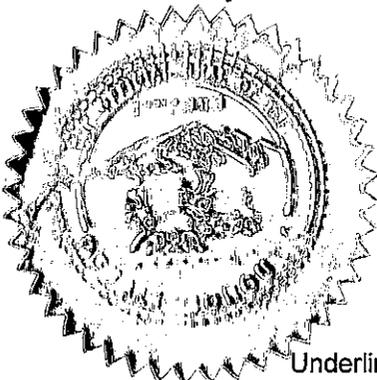
