AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING MUNICIPAL OFFICERS AND PUBLIC OFFICIALS OF THE DENALI BOROUGH FROM BEING REQUIRED TO FILE ALASKA PUBLIC OFFICES COMMISSION PUBLIC OFFICIAL FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENTS AND CREATING THE DENALI BOROUGH PUBLIC OFFICIAL FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that,

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature.

Section 2. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Chapter 8.05.120 of the Denali Borough Code of Ordinances as follow:

8.05.120 Conflict of interest statement requirement.

A. No candidate's nomination petition [or filing fees] for an elected municipal office may be accepted by the clerk unless the candidate has [also] filed a [report of financial and business interest as required by AS 39.50.010] Denali Borough Public Official Financial Disclosure Statement (Form F). [In the event such petition or filing fee has been accepted without such statement, the clerk shall return such items to the candidate.]

B. A write-in candidate who wins election shall execute a report of financial [and business interest as required by AS 39.50.010 through 39.50.200] disclosure statement prior to taking the oath of office.

C. A person who has on file with the borough clerk a [report of financial and business interest as required by AS 39.50.010 through 39.50.200] Denali Borough Public Official Financial Disclosure Statement (Form F) for the current year shall not be required to file such a statement required under subsection A or B of this section. Candidates are required to comply with AS 15.13.010 through 15.13.130 as regards election spending.

D. Public officials include elected officials and members of boards and commissions with decision making authority, regardless of whether the membership on the board or commission is salaried or unsalaried. A public official has a financial interest in a decision if it is reasonably foreseeable that the decision will have a material financial effect on one or more of his or her economic interests.

E. The Denali Borough Public Official Financial Disclosure Statement (Denali Borough Code of Ordinances, Appendix of Forms (Form F) is a public document.

F. Seated officials must file annual forms on or before April 15 of each year. Final Disclosure must be filed within 90 days of leaving office.

G. Seated officials and exiting officials who fail to file a properly completed report within the time required by this ordinance is subject to a civil penalty of \$10 a day for

each day the delinquency continues. Penalties may be appealed to the Denali Borough Assembly in written form.

Section 3 Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption of the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the mayor and approved by a majority vote at a special election of the Denali Borough to be held on March 11, 2008.
