AN ORDINANCE OF THE DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY TO PLACE BEFORE THE VOTERS A QUESTION TO OPT OUT FROM THE STATE OF ALASKA FINANCIAL OFFICIAL DISCLOSURE PROVISIONS.

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that,

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance:

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to place before the voters of the Denali Borough the question, "shall the Denali Borough opt out of the Alaska Public Offices Commission (APOC) disclosure requirements as provided in Alaska Statute 39.50.010 [and create the Denali Borough's own financial disclosure provisions and forms] using the State of Alaska, 1999 Conflict of Interest Statement Form?


Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption of the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the mayor and approved by a majority vote at the regular election of the Denali Borough to be held on November 4, 2008.


