ORDINANCE NO. 08-22

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING UP TO \$20,000 FROM THE MAJOR SCHOOL MAINTENANCE RESERVE FUND FOR INSTALLATION OF A NEW WELL AT THE CANTWELL SCHOOL.

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that;

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to appropriate \$20,000 from the Major School Maintenance Reserve Fund for reimbursement to the Denali Borough School District for the complete installation of a new well system. (Note: These funds will be credited as the required portion of the local contribution to install a well and sprinkler system for fire protection at the Cantwell School as per the Denali Borough School District Capital Improvement Project List.)


Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Mayor.
