AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DENALI BOROUGH CODE ALLOWING THE
SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON ELECTION DAY.

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

Section 1 Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature.

Section 2 Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the Denali Borough Code of Ordinances Chapter 8.05 to add Section 8.05.150 titled Alcoholic beverage sales as follows:


8.05.150 Alcoholic beverage sales.


In accordance with AS 04.16.070(b), the provisions of AS 04.16.070(a) do not apply within the Denali Borough, and alcoholic beverages may be sold, bartered, given, consumed or dispensed in [a] licensed premises on election day[.] **except within 200 feet of a polling place.**

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the borough assembly and signature of the mayor.
