**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ALLOWING GRAVEL  
EXTRACTION IN THE STAMPEDE 1.7 MILE GRAVEL PIT**

WHEREAS, all formal acts by the Planning Commission must be by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the 1.7 mile gravel pit on the Stampede Road was awarded to the Denali Borough as part of its Municipal Land Entitlement; and

WHEREAS, the 1.7 mile gravel pit has been used for gravel extraction for approximately three decades; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough intends to maintain the historic use of this site; and

WHEREAS, Panguingue Creek Homeowners Association representatives have testified at three separate public hearings, in 2010, and made direct requests to the Planning Commission and the Mayor that they be allowed to continue to use the gravel pit as a source of material for minor, public road improvements in the Panguingue Creek Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, until such time as the land is classified the Planning Commission recommends a Special Use Permit be issued to the Panguingue Creek Homeowners Association for the extraction of gravel as per DB Code 4.10.070 Temporary use of borough land; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Denali Borough Planning Commission supports allowing the issuance of a special use permit to the Panguingue Creek Homeowners Association for gravel extraction at the 1.7 mile Stampede Road gravel pit.
