

Recycle Program

Located at the Cantwell Transfer Station

Items collected will be **aluminum, paper, plastics #1** (Salad dressing bottles, soda, water, juice bottles, and coffee creamer bottles) and **plastics #2** (Milk jugs, shampoo bottles, laundry detergent, and bleach containers.)

As the program grows, more items will be accepted.

Recycled items brought to the recycle center will not be charged towards your trash fee. Participant is responsible to separate recycled items and trash.

The Recycle program is open to all Borough Residents.

Hours of Operations are the same as the Cantwell Transfer Station

Monday – 10am – 2pm

Wednesday – 4pm – 9pm

Background:

This program received funding from a General Assistance Program/Environmental Protection Agency grant. A big thank you to the Denali Borough for allowing us to use their vacant building at the transfer station for your convenience.

When the IGAP/EPA coordinator and assistant are away for training, the recycle program will not be in operation and the transfer station employee will have **NO** responsibility in collecting recycling. We will be sure to post notices of closure dates ahead of time on bulletin boards and on Cantwell's Facebook page.
