ORDINANCE NO. 15-07

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING UP TO \$25,478 FROM THE GENERAL FUND FOR REIMBURSABLE EXPENDITURES RELATED TO STATE HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM GRANT

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to approve and accept 2015 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) grant funds and to appropriate up to \$25,478 from the General Fund for reimbursable expenditures related to this grant. Eligible expenditures include tactical trauma care training facilitated by the Cantwell Volunteer Fire Department, tactical trauma care supplies to be distributed borough-wide, a thermal imaging camera for the Tri-Valley Fire Volunteer Department, and 2016 Alaska Shield participation per the grant application and obligating award documents.

Section 3. Granting Agency. SHSP grants are funded by the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management through the State of Alaska to support, build, and sustain the ability of states to prevent, protect against, mitigate, respond to, and recover from terrorist attacks and other all-hazards events.

Section 4. Requirements. No funds will be reimbursed until Borough representatives attend a 2015 Grant Kick-Off Meeting. SHSP recipients are required to submit timely quarterly progress reports.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
