AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DENALI BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 2.05 TITLED BOROUGH ASSEMBLY BY ADDING SECTION 2.05.055 TITLED AUTHORITY OF ASSEMBLY MEMBERS.

BE IT ENACTED by the Denali Borough Assembly, Alaska that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the Denali Borough Code of Ordinances and create Chapter 2.02.055 to read as follows:

2.02.055 Authority of assembly members.

Assembly members have authority only when acting as an assembly in session. The assembly shall not be bound by statements or actions of an individual assembly member or employee of the borough except when such statement or action is in accordance with the instructions of the assembly as recorded in meeting minutes.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Mayor.
