AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$40,000 FROM THE CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND
TO CONSTRUCT A NEW OFFICE/GATE HOUSE AT THE CANTWELL TRANSFER
STATION

BE IT ENACTED by the Denali Borough Assembly, that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to appropriate \$40,000 from the Capital Projects Fund to construct a larger and more efficient, ADA compliant office/gate house at the Cantwell Transfer Station. This project will ensure a more efficient and compliant work station for the workforce employed for operation of the transfer station.

Section 3. Procedure. This project will be completed in accordance with Denali Borough Code 3.35, Procurement, Procedures, and Contracting Standards and any proposal will be based on the attached document labeled Exhibit A.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Mayor.
