AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4.03 OF ARTICLE IV OF THE DENALI BOROUGH CHARTER REGARDING THE MAYOR'S TERM LIMIT

BE IT ENACTED by the Denali Borough Assembly that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend the Denali Borough Charter, Article IV, Section 4.03 (4) as follows:

Section 4.03 Election and Term of Mayor

4. No person who has completed [three (3)] two (2) consecutive full terms as Mayor may serve another term or portion of a term until a period of 180 days has passed since the end of their [third] second consecutive full term of office. A full term of office means the regular term of office for mayor and does not include portions of a term served by appointment or election to the remainder of an unexpired term vacated by another person.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly, signature of the Mayor and approved by a majority vote at the next regular election.
