AN ORDINANCE AMENDING DENALI BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 8 TITLED,
ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

Section 1 Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature.

Section 2 Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend Denali Borough Code of Ordinances 8.15.130 as follows:

8.15.130 Rules for counting ballots.


D. Write-in votes shall be tabulated according to the following rules:

4. All write-in votes shall be tallied[.],with the exception of those which contain expletives or additional comments deemed to be derisive to a candidate or any other individual.


Section 3 Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption of the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Mayor.
