AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING UP TO \$176,216 FROM THE MAJOR SCHOOL MAINTENANCE FUND FOR THE CANTWELL K-12 SCHOOL SPRINKLER AND FIRE ALARM UPGRADE PROJECT

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to appropriate up to \$176,216 from the Major School Maintenance Reserve Fund as the Borough's participating share of the Cantwell K-12 School Sprinkler and Fire Alarm Upgrade project – State of Alaska Department of Education and Early Development project number GR-14-009.

Section 3. Procedure. This project will be completed in accordance with Denali Borough Code 3.35, Procurement, Procedures, and Contracting Standards, the Project Agreement for this project, and the laws of the State of Alaska.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
