AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING UP TO \$24,000 FROM THE GENERAL FUND  
FOR EXPENDITURES RELATED TO GRANT 13EMPG-34457

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to approve and accept 2013 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) number 13EMPG-GR34457, to appropriate up to \$12,000 from the General Fund for reimbursable expenditures related to this grant as well as up to \$12,000 in match expenditures. Eligible expenditures include salary and benefits for the Emergency Services Director per the obligating award documents.


Section 3. Granting Agency. EMPG grants are funded by the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management through the State of Alaska to support emergency management activities.

Section 4. Requirements. EMPG recipients are required to perform projects identified in the borough's 2013 EMPG Work Plan, complete Alaska Assessment, attend the State's Multi-Year Training and Exercise Plan Workshop, participate in three exercises, work with the National Incident Management System, complete the FEMA Independent Study Professional Development Series, timely report quarterly progress, and provide a dollar for dollar in-kind match

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
