AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE MAYOR'S ANNUAL SALARY FROM \$65,000 TO \$81,000

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to increase the annual salary of the mayor from \$65,000 to \$81,000 and to set the effective date for the first meeting after the 2014 mayoral election.

Section 3. Authority. Denali Borough Code of Ordinances, Chapter 2.10.060

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective at the first meeting after the 2014 mayoral election, [and] upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly[, and signature of the Mayor, [and approved by a majority vote at the next regular election.]
