AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING UP TO \$63,650 FROM THE GENERAL FUND
FOR REIMBURSABLE EXPENDITURES RELATED TO GRANT 13SHSP-GR34078

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to approve and accept 2013 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) number 13SHSP-GR34078, to appropriate up to \$63,650 from the General Fund for reimbursable expenditures related to this grant. Eligible expenditures include heart monitors for the Tri-Valley Volunteer Fire Department and vests/cases for emergency operations center staff per the obligating award documents.

Section 3. Granting Agency. SHSP grants are funded by the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management through the State of Alaska to support, build, and sustain the ability of states to prevent, protect against, mitigate, respond to, and recover from terrorist attacks and other all-hazards events.

Section 4. Requirements. No funds will be reimbursed until Borough representatives attend a 2013 Grant Kick-Off Meeting in November, 2013. SHSP recipients are required to submit timely quarterly progress reports.


Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.


