AN ORDINANCE CREATING DENALI BOROUGH CODE OF ORDINANCES TITLE 7, BUSINESS LICENSES AND REGULATIONS AND CREATING CHAPTER 7.05, TITLED LIQUOR LICENSES

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

Section 1 Classification. This ordinance is of a general and permanent nature.

Section 2 Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to create Title 7, to be titled Business Licenses and Regulations and to create Chapter 7.05 to the Denali Borough Code of Ordinances titled Liquor Licenses as follows:

**Chapter 7.05**

**LIQUOR LICENSES**

Sections:

- 7.05.010 Purpose
- 7.05.020 Authority
- 7.05.030 Hours of Sale
- 7.05.040 Clearing of the Premises
- 7.05.050 Presence on Licensed Premises During Closure Hours

**7.05.010 Purpose**

The purpose of this ordinance is to establish the hours during which alcohol can legally be sold in the Denali Borough.

**7.05.020 Authority**

Alaska Statute 29.35.080 and 04.16.010 (d)

**7.05.030 Hours of sale**

A person shall not sell, offer for sale, give, furnish, deliver, or consume an alcoholic beverage on premises licensed under AS 04.11.080 between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. every day in the calendar year.

**7.05.040 Clearing of the Premises**

Licensed premises will be allowed a 60-minute "safety hour" starting at 3:00 a.m. and ending at 4:00 a.m. after which no customers and patrons shall remain on the premises. No alcoholic beverages may be sold, offered for sale, given, furnished, delivered, dispensed or consumed during the safety hour and clearing period.

**7.05.050 Presence on Licensed Premises During Closing Hours**

Except for the clearing period set forth in DBC 7.05.040, a licensee, an agent, or employee may not permit a person to enter or remain on the licensed premises between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. every day in the calendar year. This subsection does not apply to common carriers or to an employee of the licensee who is on the premises to prepare for the next day's business. A person may enter or remain on the premises of a bona fide restaurant or eating place licensed under this title to consume food or nonalcoholic beverages.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective 30 days upon adoption of the Denali Borough Assembly, signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
