ORDINANCE NO. 15-06

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 6.15 OF THE DENALI BOROUGH CODE OF
ORDINANCE, TITLED SOLID WASTE

INTRODUCED BY: CLAY WALKER

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska.

Section 1. Classification. The ordinance is of a permanent nature.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend DBC Chapter 6.15 as follows:

**Chapter 6.15
SOLID WASTE**

6.15.030 Landfill/Transfer Station, Waste accepted.

The borough landfill and transfer stations shall accept approved solid waste from within the solid waste disposal area.

A. The borough landfill may accept MSW, separated household hazardous waste and special waste.

B. The borough transfer station(s) may accept residential MSW and separated household hazardous waste.

6.15.070 Tipping fees and charge accounts.

A. Contractual Agreements. Any tipping fee adjustments will be pursuant to any contractual agreements between the borough and others. New tipping fees will become effective only upon renewal of any and all contracts.

B. Tipping Fee Review. The mayor or his designee shall periodically review at least annually and recommend changes, if any, to the tipping fee schedule. Any changes shall be made by non-code ordinance with RCA consideration. Tipping fee increases will have [and with] a minimum effective date of six months. The assembly shall take into consideration the escalation factor under advisement from the RCA.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption of the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
