ORDINANCE NO. 16-03

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING UP TO \$310,000 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND TO CONSTRUCT AN EXTENSION OF THE LANDFILL SHOP BUILDING

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to appropriate funds from the Capital Improvements Fund to build an extension of the existing landfill shop building. The Denali Borough Assembly identified this need in state funding request Resolutions 11-26 and 12-22, stating the intent "to provide space for heavy equipment and storage for maintenance and repair items." The borough received State of Alaska DCCED Grant 13-DM-223 in the amount of \$50,000 toward this project.


Section 3. Appropriation – Source and Amount. The Denali Borough Assembly appropriates up to \$310,000 from the Capital Improvements Fund.

Section 4. Procedure. The project will be completed in accordance with Denali Borough Code 3.35, titled "Procurement, Procedures, and Contracting Standards."

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption of the Denali Borough Assembly and the signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
