AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE HEALY TRANSPORTATION AND PEDESTRIAN SAFETY PLAN
AND TO AMEND THE DENALI BOROUGH COMPREHENSIVE PLAN TO INCORPORATE THE
“PLAN” AS WRITTEN

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough Assembly approved Resolution 14-07 to form the Denali Borough Healy Transportation and Pedestrian Safety (HTAPS) Mayor’s Adhoc Committee, and

WHEREAS, through Denali Borough Assembly Resolution 14-07, the committee was charged with developing a road and trail safety plan for the Healy area, and

WHEREAS, the committee worked jointly with the Alaska Department of Transportation, citizens, and stakeholders within the borough to gather information on suggestions for vehicular, bicycle and pedestrian safety near Healy, Alaska, and

WHEREAS, this work included numerous meetings of the committee, extensive public involvement, facilitated meetings and visioning workshops, and

WHEREAS, after consideration of all evidence and opinion available, the Healy Transportation and Pedestrian Safety Adhoc Committee prepared the Healy Transportation and Pedestrian Safety Plan for review by the Denali Borough Assembly, and

WHEREAS, by this ordinance, the Denali Borough Assembly acknowledges and appreciates the time and hard work required to produce the professional document that HTAPS provided for the borough, and enacts as follows:

BE IT ENACTED by the Assembly of the Denali Borough, Alaska that:

Section 1. Classification. This ordinance is a non-code ordinance.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to adopt the Healy Transportation and Pedestrian Safety Plan as presented by the Healy Transportation and Pedestrian Safety Mayor’s Adhoc Committee to the Denali Borough Assembly and to amend the Denali Borough Comprehensive Plan to incorporate the Healy Transportation and Pedestrian Safety Plan as presented.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance becomes effective upon adoption by the Denali Borough Assembly and signature of the Denali Borough Mayor.
