RESOLUTION NO. 11-27

A RESOLUTION BY THE DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY ENCOURAGING THE GOVERNOR OF ALASKA AND THE ALASKA STATE LEGISLATURE TO PROVIDE CAPITAL BUDGET FUNDING FOR THE ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO UPGRADE RURAL ROADS IN STATE SUBDIVISIONS WITHIN THE DENALI BOROUGH

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough has numerous residential developments within subdivisions, some of which were developed by the State of Alaska, and

WHEREAS, the primitive roads which currently serve the subdivisions sometimes create limits on access and the type of vehicle which can navigate the transportation corridor, and

WHEREAS, there are parcels still available but poor access limits the marketability of these properties, and

WHEREAS, road improvements into these areas will encourage private ownership of land and will enhance the marketing to dispose of these properties, and

WHEREAS, there is currently an insignificant amount of private parcels for residents to build homes to reside within the Denali Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; that the Denali Borough Assembly and the Administration request that \$600,000 (six hundred thousand dollars) be included in the FY 2013 Capital Budget and be specified for the Department of Transportation for basic road upgrades within the following subdivisions:

Windy Creek/Southwind  
Kobe Ag/Anderson  
June Creek  
Panguingue Creek  
Village View Subdivision
