RESOLUTION NO. 13-02

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF REINTRODUCTION AND PASSAGE OF A BILL TO CREATE THE
STAMPEDE STATE RECREATION AREA**

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough Assembly has previously passed four resolutions in support of the establishment of the Stampede State Recreation Area; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of the Stampede State Recreation Area is supported by the Denali Borough Planning Commission as presented in Resolution PC 11-03; and

WHEREAS, these resolutions outline important reasons that a Stampede State Recreation Area would be valuable to residents of the Denali Borough and the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, land within the proposed Stampede State Recreation Area have been recognized by the State of Alaska as unique and important for public recreation and wildlife habitat.

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has acknowledged, in response to comments on the Yukon Tanana Area Plan, that formation of a state recreation area as previously introduced in legislation is appropriate for establishment in this area and that promotion of the SRA should come from the local community and its state representatives.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Denali Borough Assembly requests that the Alaska State Legislature move expeditiously to reintroduce and pass a bill to establish the Stampede State Recreation Area.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Denali Borough Assembly supports the designation of State Recreation Area lands to include: Fairbanks Meridian, Healy Quadrangle, Township 12S8W sections 6, 7, 18, 19, 30, 31; Townships 12S9W, 12S10W, 12S11W; Township 13S9W sections 1-6 and 7-12, excluding National Park lands; Township 13S10W sections 1-6 and 7-12 excluding National Park lands; Township 13S11W sections 1-6 and 7-12 excluding National Park lands.
