RESOLUTION NO 13-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY APPROVING THE DESTRUCTION OF RECORDS

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough Code Title 1 General Provisions Chapter 1.20 Section 1.20.060 Retention and disposal states that all borough records shall be retained until the assembly, in writing, authorizes their disposal; and

WHEREAS, the Code furthers that the disposal schedule shall be in accordance with the state of Alaska Local Government General Records retention schedule; and

WHEREAS, the Code stipulates the Denali Borough Clerk shall periodically review the borough records to determine whether she considers said records to be without legal, administrative, or historical value; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough Clerk has reported numerous events of flooding in the records storage area to the Borough landlord, mayor and assembly; and

WHEREAS, the flooding events have destroyed some borough records between 1999 and 2010; and

WHEREAS; the borough office has relocated the borough records to a new storage area, when one became available, in 2010 to prevent further damage to the borough records; and

WHEREAS, the clerk has identified records in accordance with the schedule of the state of Alaska she deems appropriate to be destroyed; and

WHEREAS, the clerk has provided the Denali Borough Assembly with lists of these records and recommends that the records be destroyed by shredding.

Now therefore be it resolved that the Denali Borough Assembly approves of the destruction of the public records enumerated in the January 2013 and 2014 Request for Records Destruction.
