RESOLUTION NO. 14-05**

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF PASSAGE OF HOUSE BILL 148 TO CREATE THE
STAMPEDE STATE RECREATION AREA**

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough Assembly has long supported of the establishment of the Stampede State Recreation Area; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of the Stampede State Recreation Area is supported by the Denali Borough Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, previous resolutions outline the many important reasons that a Stampede State Recreation Area would be valuable to residents of the Denali Borough and the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Stampede State Recreation Area lands have been recognized by the State of Alaska as unique and important for public recreation and wildlife habitat; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has acknowledged in the Yukon Tanana Area Plan that creation of a State Recreation Area is compatible with the land use designations and management intent of the Wolf Townships and is appropriate for establishment in this area.

WHEREAS, each passing year brings increased recreation and tourism to the Stampede area, with visitors from across Alaska and from around the world, making the establishment of a State Recreation Area critical to maintaining the attractive quality of the area and improving public safety.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Denali Borough Assembly requests that the Alaska State Legislature move expeditiously to pass House Bill 148, a bill to establish the Stampede State Recreation Area.
