A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PANGUINGUE CREEK HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION  
(PCHA) REQUEST FOR STATE OF ALASKA FUNDING

WHEREAS, the Panguingue Creek Subdivision is located within the Denali Borough, and

WHEREAS, the Panguingue Creek Subdivision was created by the State of Alaska and has road right of ways platted and owned by the State of Alaska, and

WHEREAS, damage to the right of way on Antares Street has limited access to homeowners, and

WHEREAS, PCHA has efficiently and effectively constructed and maintained roads within the subdivision for residents and visitors for over 20 years, and

WHEREAS, the PCHA is non-profit, qualified 501(c)3 organization with the capacity to effectively administer this project, and

WHEREAS, PCHA requests a one-time appropriation from the state of Alaska to repair damage to Antares Street and restore access for homeowners.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; the Denali Borough Assembly supports the Panguingue Creek Homeowners Association in its request for a direct appropriation from the state of Alaska.

\$82,500 Repair and Extension of an Un-built, Platted Subdivision Road on State Land.

Antares Road within the Panguingue Creek Subdivision has been constructed along much of its platted length, but beyond the hardened surface the tundra has become severely damaged and impassable to vehicular and foot traffic. Constructing the remainder of the platted road will repair damage within the road right-of-way and will provide access to homes and private land within the state subdivision.
