A RESOLUTION OF THE DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING GOVERNOR  
WALKER'S PROPOSED DEPOSIT OF \$57 MILLION INTO THE REVENUE SHARING FUND FOR  
FISCAL YEAR 2016

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough Assembly is the governing body of the Denali Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough is a political subdivision of the State of Alaska; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough is appreciative to the Governor and the Legislature for the continuation of the Revenue Sharing Program; and

WHEREAS, since 2008, Alaska's municipalities have received a total of \$60 million per year to be divided among all boroughs, cities and unorganized communities in the state; and

WHEREAS, Revenue Sharing funds are vital to the Denali Borough's ability to support essential services to its citizens, while keeping taxes as low as possible; and

WHEREAS, Revenue Sharing funds have provided essential support for the volunteer fire departments of the unincorporated communities of Healy and Cantwell, which are located within the Denali Borough; and

WHEREAS, Revenue Sharing funds have allowed the Denali Borough to provide additional support to the City of Anderson; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough supports the continuation of \$60 million annual deposits into the Revenue Sharing Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough understands the need of the State of Alaska to reduce FY 2016 expenditures given the current revenue outlook; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough accepts the Governor's proposed reduction in the FY 2016 Revenue Sharing funding amount.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Denali Borough expresses strong support for Governor Walker's proposed deposit of \$57 million into the Revenue Sharing Fund for FY 2016; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Denali Borough Assembly respectfully requests the Alaska State Legislature continue its support of Alaska's political subdivisions by funding the Governor's proposed \$57 million Revenue Sharing deposit in FY 2016.
