A RESOLUTION BY THE DENALI BOROUGH ASSEMBLY SUPPORTING THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC FACILITIES (ADOT&PF) PROPOSAL TO RESURFACE THE HEALY RIVER AIRPORT RUNWAY, APRONS AND TAXIWAYS

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough Assembly is governing body of the Denali Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Healy River Airport serves Healy, the largest community in the Denali Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Healy River Airport is located just 12 miles from the entrance to Denali National Park, which attracts roughly 400,000 visitors annually; and

WHEREAS, the Healy River Airport serves as a base for life flight operations, flightseeing operations, guiding operations, and also supports mining and utility operations; and

WHEREAS, the Healy River Airport is vital to the transport needs of the Denali Borough, especially regarding emergency response; and

WHEREAS, all eleven sections of pavement at the Healy River Airport are between 16 and 20 years old; and

WHEREAS, the 2014 Alaska Airport Pavement Inspection Report recommends pavement rehabilitation at the Healy River Airport.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: that the Denali Borough Assembly supports the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities proposal to resurface the Healy River Airport runway, aprons, and taxiways.
