A RESOLUTION ALLOWING GOLDEN VALLEY ELECTRIC ASSOCIATION  
INGRESS AND EGRESS TO BOROUGH OWNED LANDS FOR THE  
PURPOSE OF SURVEYING THE CENTERLINE OF A PROPOSED  
POWERLINE.

WHEREAS, GVEA has received a grant from the Alaska Energy Authority to construct the Parks Highway Electric Distribution Line Extension project; and

**Whereas**, the project involves constructing approximately 27 miles of new single-phase distribution power line from the Rex Bridge to Stampede Road, and 8 miles of single-phase distribution taps; and

**Whereas**, the construction of the new electrical distribution line will bring power to the currently unserved areas along the Parks Highway between Healy and Nenana; and

**Whereas**, The power line route will cross state and private lands, Denali Borough lands, the Alaska Railroad, the Nenana River, and GVEA would like to begin field surveying for the power line centerline within the next several weeks. The route map is attached.


