**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF PASSAGE OF A  
BILL TO CREATE THE STAMPEDE STATE RECREATION AREA DURING THE  
28TH LEGISLATIVE SESSION.**

WHEREAS, all formal acts by the Planning Commission must be by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Denali Borough's local government is well suited to make recommendations for land use within the Denali Borough and has supported the creation of a Stampede State Recreation area in multiple previous resolutions; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of the Stampede State Recreation Area is supported by the Denali Borough Assembly; and

WHEREAS, there are no State Parks, Recreation Sites or Areas located within the Denali Borough; and

WHEREAS, the designation of a Stampede State Recreation Area provides an opportunity to maintain traditional uses on public lands adjacent to settlement lands; and


WHEREAS, the designation of a Stampede State Recreation Area would provide recreational opportunities for residents within the Borough and throughout the State; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has acknowledged in the Yukon Tanana Area Plan that a State Recreation Area designation would be compatible with the land use designations and management intent of the proposed units.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Denali Borough Planning Commission requests that the Alaska Legislature pass HB 148 to create a Stampede State Recreation Area in a timely manner.
